Explanatory Notes

Membership types:

Adult (£30): Anyone over 18.

Junior (£15): Anyone under 18.

Family (£37.50): Includes one adult and any number of juniors from the same household.

MOD Pass: Barry Buddon is an active military base where live firing regularly takes place on the ranges and military exercises utilise the open ground. Red flags are flown at such times and the public is not allowed in. We are permitted access to our site even when the flags are flying but we need a pass to show the gate sentry. To get a pass new members must supply two passport photos, signed on the back by themselves, and the details of their vehicle(s). These are given to the club secretary who applies for a pass on your behalf.

S.A.A. membership and insurance:

Use of Barry Buddon is dependant upon everyone who flies there having insurance of a required standard and level of cover. The insurance provided by the three main model flying associations are the only types approved. The club is run following S.A.A. rules and safety procedures so we recommend you join the S.A.A. However, B.M.F.A. or L.M.A membership and insurance is also accepted. Please visit the website of your chosen association and follow their joining procedure. Proof of membership, in the form of a scan or picture of your membership card or document must be provided to the club secretary as soon as it is available.

C.A.A. registration:

It is a legal requirement for all operators of model aircraft and drones weighing more than 250g at take off to be registered with the Civil Aviation Authority. How to go about this is clearly laid out on the drone registration website and involves some reading and a short multiple choice test to make sure you understand the rules and responsibilities involved, but is not difficult. It costs £9 to register. When you get your operator number you should let the club secretary know what it is.

Club communication:

The primary method of keeping in touch with the membership is email so it is important you supply an email address that you check regularly. We also have a WhatsApp group where emails are duplicated and general information is exchanged. It is also handy for finding out who will be at the field and when, and keeping in touch generally.

Subscription payment:

At the moment we can only accept payment by cheque, or by cash if you meet a committee member in person (please do not send cash through the post).
